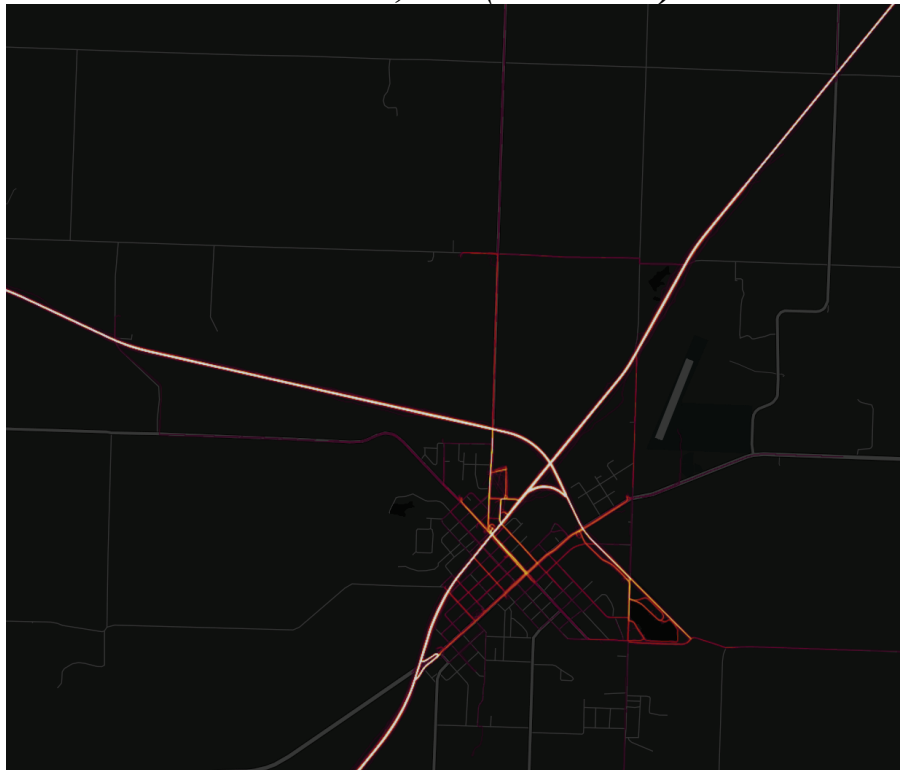
Bicycle Heatmap – Downtown KC vs Katy Trail
